NOTES:

- When choosing your general education courses, be sure to choose at least ONE marked with *. Any course marked with * will fulfill both your general education requirement and your International Education requirement.
- All professional education and content-area coursework that forms part of an application for Illinois Teacher Certification, endorsement, or approval that is received on or after February 1, 2012, must have been passed with a grade no lower than "C" or equivalent in order to be counted towards fulfillment of the applicable requirements for teacher certification.
- A minimum of 45 semester hours in the Associate of Arts Degree in Early Childhood Education is required for admittance to the Kendall UCLC transfer program in Early Childhood Education with IL 04 Certification. A completed AA in ECE is recommended.
- It is highly recommended that students pass the "Illinois Basic Skills Test" prior to transferring to Kendall College for the Early Childhood Education with IL 04 Teacher Certification Program. The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) has implemented a new policy regarding the Illinois Certification Testing System (ICTS). Beginning January 12, 2010, no individual may attempt to pass the same ICTS test more than five times. Any previous test attempts for the same test made prior to January 12, 2010, do not count toward the five-time limit.
