

# BA OR BGS IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

NORTH PARK UNIVERSITY

The Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of General Studies in Business Administration provides students with the analytical tools and competencies needed to be successful in a business career. The major is designed to provide skills and knowledge in marketing, finance, accounting, communications and general management practices. A degree in Business Administration will prepare students for advancement in the workplace. Business Administration Majors can pursue a wide variety of career goals. Many graduates go on to pursue graduate degrees in business.

## TARGET AUDIENCE:

Adult bachelor's degree completion students with previous college experience who wish to take classes in an accelerated format.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- at least 12 sh from an accredited college or university;
- at least 2.0 gpa (on a 4.0 scale);
- free online application;
- official transcripts from all colleges attended.

Prospective students may fax applications and unofficial transcripts for the initial evaluation.

## COST:

\$490 per semester hour. Ask about scholarships.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Submit free application and official transcripts from all colleges attended. Prospective students may fax applications and unofficial transcripts for the initial evaluation. Upon evaluation and acceptance, students are referred to a School of Adult Learning advisor to discuss program options and orientation.

## ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

Year-round calendar with six intensive sessions. Each session is seven weeks in duration.

## DELIVERY MODE:

Bachelor's degree in Business Administration available face-to-face, online, or hybrid.

## LOCATION(S) OF COURSES:

## TEXTBOOK PURCHASE:

Texts are available online through North Park bookstore website.

## TRANSFER HOURS POLICY:

Students may transfer a maximum of 90 semester hours of credit from a community college or up to 90 semester hours of credit from an accredited four-year college or university. Courses will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.

## TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:

Minimum of 120 semester hours, including all major and general education requirements.

## SPECIAL CHARACTERISTICS:

- Accelerated and intensive class sessions meet once a week for seven weeks.
- Two degree options (BA and BGS) provide flexibility for transfer students.
- Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) is a systematic process by which School of Adult Learning students may earn academic credit for prior learning gained outside of a traditional classroom setting. College-level learning is awarded when the student is able to demonstrate learning, whether from informal life experience, professional training, certification, licensure, or any other source.
