

MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MBA)

NORTH PARK UNIVERSITY

The broad based curriculum of the North Park MBA provides a thorough core of knowledge in all business disciplines, while offering the flexibility to specialize in functional areas through concentrations in several different areas. Special attention is given to ethics and integrating ethical thinking into management practice. Students in the MBA program take 13 core courses and 5 electives.

TARGET AUDIENCE:

Professionals who seek to expand their career options and scope of responsibility through advanced management education.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- A Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- Completed application and current resume
- Two completed recommendation forms
- Official transcripts from all colleges attended
- GMAT or GRE required if cumulative GPA is below 3.0. Waived if applicant has a graduate degree from an accredited institution or completes first 5 SBNM courses with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better as a nondegree student.

COST:

\$2,070 per course (2 Semester Hours)

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

A quad system. Each quad is seven weeks and there are five quads in a year, starting August, October, January, March and May.

DELIVERY MODE:

All classes are delivered face-to-face through lecture, case study, Socratic discussion, and group activities.

LOCATION(S) OF COURSES:

University Center facility in Grayslake or online.

TEXTBOOK PURCHASE:

Texts may be purchased online or by phone from North Park's Bookstore, or from another online provider.

TRANSFER HOURS POLICY:

Up to 4 courses (8 sh) from an accredited graduate program. Also, up to 2 courses may be waived if taken at the undergraduate level with a grade of "B" or higher.

TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:

32-36 depending upon undergraduate preparation.

FINANCIAL AID INFO:

One of the most comprehensive scholarship programs for part time grad students in the U.S. You will automatically receive the highest scholarship for which you qualify; no separate application required. An Armed Forces Scholarship reduces tuition by 20% for active duty military members, full-time National Guard, and their spouses. An Axelson Scholarship reduces tuition by 35% for full-time employees of nonprofit organizations or those who completed a successful tour of service with the Peace Corps or AmeriCorps. A Married Couples Scholarship reduces each course by \$100 when both spouses are registered in the same term. Federal Stafford Loans and convenient payment plans are also available.

SPECIAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Courses can also be taken at the main campus on the north side of Chicago or online.
