REQUIRED COURSES:

The MPH in PHI program is a 51-credit hour online program, which consists of public health and informatics coursework, a field practicum and a capstone project. A complete list of the MPH in PHI can be found at:

The MPH PHI curriculum is designed to deepen understanding of population health and develop expertise in public health informatics. It is ideal for state/local public health agency personnel, staff of managed care organizations and pharmaceutical companies, international health agency personnel, federal health officers, physicians/other healthcare providers, IT professionals and veterans/military personnel. Students will learn: principles of public health, enriched within the context of public health informatics; definitions and standards of health data; issues and solutions surrounding privacy and confidentiality concerns; structure and uses of public health databases and networks; applications of the basic functions and operations of public health information technologies; strategies for developing or adapting public health-related information systems; planning, procurement and management objectives and standards for public health information systems projects; development and uses of web-based public health informatics applications, public health geographic information systems, and data mining.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Prospective applicants are required to submit the following in order to be considered for admission to the MPH in PHI degree program:*

- Completed UIC Application and Fee
- Completed SOPHAS Application and Fee
- Transcripts
- GRE Scores
- Current Resume or Curriculum Vitae
- Personal Statement
- References (minimum of three)
- TOEFL Scores (for international students only)
